# **RMC** costs

The following fees are paid to the Centre for centre fees, hiring or buying an instrument, music books and extras. We prefer online banking and ask all fees to be paid by 9 February 2019. If an enrolment is cancelled before Saturday 16 February 2019, we will refund the Centre fees paid. There will be no refund paid if a student cancels an enrolment on or after Saturday 16 February 2019.

**Internet Banking**: remember to insert the 6-digit payment identifier in the particular field before 9 February 2019.

If you cannot make an internet banking deposit please post a cheque with the payment form to Raroa Music Centre, 38 Garden Road, Northland Wellington 6012.

It takes us a few weeks to reconcile payments so the online enrolment system may continue to say that you owe money until we have done the reconciliation.

### Hiring an instrument from Raroa Music Centre

You need an instrument to practise on and to bring to class.

There are keyboards at the Centre for lessons, but you will need to get your own keyboard or piano to practise on at home.

For \$150 per year you can hire a

- cello
- flute
- brass (trumpet or trombone)
- clarinet or
- saxophone.

A family can hire only one instrument each year. Hire fees must be paid in full before the first day of classes unless special arrangements are made with the Centre. The parent committee may authorise a second hire per family if there are instruments available, but this is not guaranteed and will be considered on a case by case basis.

When you are registering don't forget to hire an instrument if you need one. Hire instruments are given out the first day of lessons.

#### Ukeleles

#### Recorders

We prefer that you buy a recorder from the teacher as we need to ensure the recorder is a suitable standard for your child to learn on. Please bring \$15 cash to the first lesson. The recorder is an AULOS www.aulosusa.com and comes with a bag and cleaning rod.

#### Guitars

The Music Warehouse **www.themusicwarehouse.co.nz** will sell guitars in the staffroom on Saturday 10 February (the first day of classes) from 9am to 2pm. Staff will tell you the right size guitar for your child and will restring and tune the guitar so it is ready to go.

They will only be selling the natural colour. If you want a black, red, or blue guitar you will need to visit the Music Warehouse yourself. Please note the shop closes at 3 pm on Saturdays and is not open on Sundays.

Some classes may have to purchase a tuition book. Your teacher will email you the details before classes start.

**Saxophone** - A New Tune a Day for Alto Sax (\$35 - \$40 or cheaper if ordered a month in advance via thebookdepository.co.uk)

Reeds are \$5-6 each and will need to be replaced every 2-3 weeks or when broken.

Clarinet - A New Tune a Day for Clarinet (\$35-\$40 or cheaper if ordered a month in advance via **thebookdepositary.co.uk**)

Reeds are \$4-5 each and will need to be replaced every 2-3 weeks or when broken.
